- For a travel grant for a conference / workshop till March 2017, you have to send an application until 30 Nov. 2016 to the GSCN office (gscn.office@mdc-berlin.de) with a short application and the abstract.
- For a travel grant for a conference / workshop till **June 2017**, you have to send an application until **28 Feb. 2016** to the GSCN office (<a href="mailto:gscn.office@mdc-berlin.de">gscn.office@mdc-berlin.de</a>) with a short application and the abstract.
- For a travel grant for a conference / workshop till September 2017, you have to send an
  application until 31 May 2016 to the GSCN office (gscn.office@mdc-berlin.de) with a short
  application and the abstract.
